**1 Respect:**

**5 Creativity:**

**6 Support:**  
Provide your students with support, both educational and personal, that they can turn to you for.



**7 Professionalism:**  
Always act professionally by showing your students that they are being taken seriously and with respect.



**8 Open to change:**  
Be flexible and ready to adjust your learning plans based on the needs and progress of your students.



**9 Personal development:**  
Keep learning, improve your teaching skills and always look for new ways to improve your work.



**10 Give Space:**  
Teach your students to be independent and active learners by encouraging them to reflect, ask questions, and do research on their own.
